I write to you because I don't know whom else to address at C-SPAN.

Re: BIAS OF C-SPAN

There is an extremely biased liberal left major media. I have watched it for years and can document that bias.

I HOPE THE REASON FOR THIS BIASED CHOP-CUT-OFF IS CORRECTED.
