Dear C-SPAN:

Thank you very much for C-SPAN 1 and 2. I watch these channels as much as possible. They are a God-send to someone who wants to see first-hand what is going on in our government.

Last night on C-SPAN I caught the tail-end of a discussion about the 1992 Cable Bill, with which I vehemently disagree. After watching President Clinton's economic speech, given in Milwaukee, in its entirety on C-SPAN last night, I started feeling very blue because last night was the last time I can watch President Clinton on C-SPAN because of the 1992 Cable Bill. C-SPAN 1 was totally cut from our cable system today and C-SPAN 2 is only on until 5:00 p.m. so people like me who work are just out of luck.

Our cable service has been FORCED to take two local channels, a Spanish channel and an Asian channel, to which I cannot relate at all. We have very few ethnic groups in our county and resent having to take these channels FROM OTHER COUNTIES! Besides, we already have one Spanish channel and one Asian channel in our county already.

I am outraged at this turn of events. I do not trust the press to report in an unbiased manner, plus I don't want some reporter or commentator giving me THEIR INTERPRETATION of what people in government do or say. I am a grown person and can and want to make up my own mind about that I see and hear, thank you.

If there is anything you can do to help us get C-SPAN 1 and 2 back in our county of 65,000 people, please do so. Thank you.
