This is a follow-up to my previous letters and articles proposing a call-in show about initiative and referendum legislation.

Governor Weicker of Connecticut promised no income tax for his first year but has already proposed an income tax. Governor Florio is facing a tax revolt in New Jersey because of massive tax increases. Governor Cuomo, a probable Presidential candidate, has rescinded two tax cuts and has raised taxes but he refuses to discuss legislative and executive staff cuts. He also doesn't discuss the public authorities that continue to sell bonds. There is, meanwhile, a complete breakdown in education, crime prevention, health, and infrastructure in New York.
