regardless of the political ramifications. The politicians are too timid. Crime, not the economy, is the number one problem.


I would like for C-SPAN to, again, devote extensive programming time to the discussion of crime, preferably with Florida, a congressional delegation.

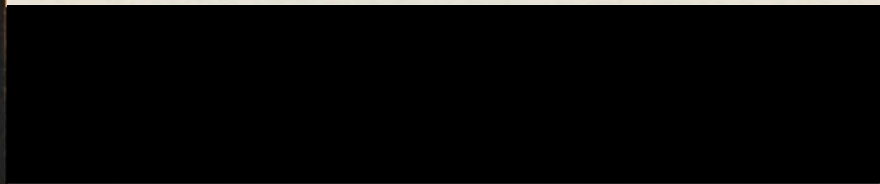
It is appalling to see the helplessness on the faces of public officials as they recount the latest tragedy. It is as if lawlessness has no remedy.
