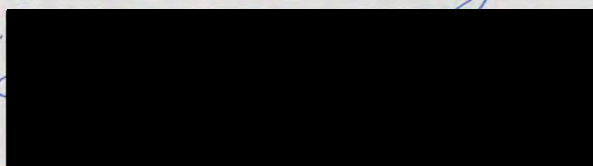
accomplished.
