Dear Mr. Lamb:

I watched your call-in program today and heard Georgie Anne Geyer discussing illegal immigration. It prompts me to raise a question that has been bothering me - in the hope you might address it in a future program.

I believe the primary reason for the U.S. census is to provide information for reapportionment of the House of Representatives. After the 1990 census, there was a lot of controversy about the accuracy of the count - particularly of immigrants. It would be interesting to hear how the count of immigrants - legal and illegal - affects reapportionment. I wonder particularly about California, which is picking up seats. Do these seats represent large numbers of non-citizens?

job you do.

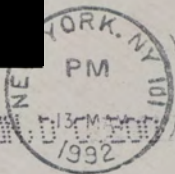
