WASHINGTON, D.C.-- C-SPAN cable network's "Campaign '86" continues along the campaign trail with a trip to St. Louis for a look at the race for Missouri's U.S. Senate seat. The contest for the state's 8th Congressional district will also be examined during C-SPAN's three-day telecast beginning Friday, May 2nd.

Lt. Gov. Harriett Woods and Oren Lee Staley, vying for the Democratic party nomination, and uncontested GOP candidate, former Gov. Christopher Bond join C-SPAN for interviews as part of Missouri election coverage.

Political analysts believe the Missouri Senate race is key for both parties. The Democrats want to retain the seat of retiring Sen. Thomas Eagleton, while the Republicans hope to add Missouri to their list of GOP pick-ups in the Senate.

C-SPAN cameras go behind-the-scenes at the candidates' political headquarters for interviews with campaign workers who will discuss the structure, focus, and dynamics of their campaigns.

Local political scientists and political journalists from the St. Louis Globe-Democrat, St. Louis Post-Dispatch, and the Kansas City Star will add their perspectives on the campaign during interviews and live viewer call-in programs.
