We truly appreciate your having these hearings on your television station and I know God will bless you.

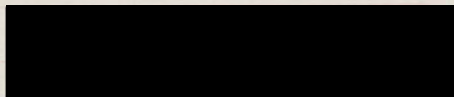


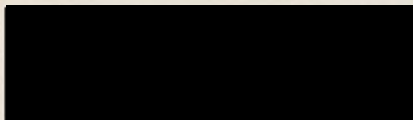
