Checks and Balances:
Where did they go?

One of the functions of the Justice Department is to oversee and monitor the Congress. What happened? It appears we have allowed Congress to remove this function by letting them (Congress) investigate themselves through which they (Congress) set up their own Ethics Committee. When Congress set up this Ethics Committee in that legislation, did they (Congress) remove the function of the Judiciary, which is part of the checks and balances? It seems that since this Ethics Committee was put in place, there have been free-wheeling scandals.
