on Thur, APRIL 9. For weeks

routine, unimportant session  
of the House is on  
instead. Your policy  
of showing uninterrupted  
coverage of the House  
in effect, holds you hostage  
to the vagaries of the  
House schedule. All  
editorial judgment as  
to what is most important  
is Relinquished. It is  
as if Congress had  
passed a law requiring  
C-SPAN to cover every minute  
of it.

The British election  
had to be covered in  
real time. It could not

LATER. your Thrall to  
The House makes your  
network unreliable. I
