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Dear Mr. Lamb,

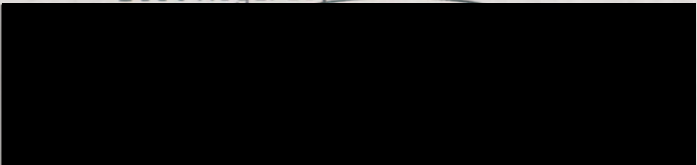
Thank you for C-SPAN, I hope you can keep as it is now!
