Swain and she had taken some still photo's while she was there. I wonder, did Mrs. Swain take any of them playing volleyball? None were shown on the program, but I just thought I would ask just in case she might have one of Tray.

Well whatever you can do would be greatly appreciated. Please write me as I would be willing to pay for all pictures and the video.

Your program is highly informative and very up to date with the courage overseas. As assistant manager of a motel I had an opportunity to watch it all week while I lived on the property and the manager was on vacation. We do not have cable in our home. I shall miss it now that I've had a taste of it.

I shall be anxiously awaiting your reply. And thank you so much for whatever you can do.
