-- C-SPAN'S "STATES OF THE NATION '85" TRAVELS TO MONTGOMERY, AL --

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- "States of the Nation '85" -- C-SPAN's tour of state capitals -- winds its way through the south to Montgomery, the political hub of Alabama.

October 29 & 30, C-SPAN looks at the political and economic issues facing Alabama leaders and Montgomery's position at the vanguard of the Civil Rights Movement.

C-SPAN's programming features viewer call-in shows originating live via satellite from Alabama's state capitol with C-SPAN hosts moderating from the network's Washington, D.C. studios. Guests include Montgomery Mayor Emory Folmar, State Sen. Larry Dixon (R), Alabama Education Assoc. and AL Democratic Conference member Dr. Joe Reed, and civil rights attorney J.L. Chestnut. In addition, longtime Alabama political journalist Bob Ingram will discuss state capitol news coverage on a viewer call-in program.

Cable viewers can also catch a scenic view of Montgomery and the surrounding area through C-SPAN's own video vignettes.
