C-Span in turn, some-how, is not satisfied until all stones are turned, to get into much detail, present facts, and search, for the exacting truth.

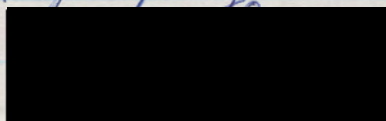
Whether I agree always, or not, it encourages me, and interests me too, to better use my own mind, to analyze what it presents.
