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**"ROAD TO THE WHITE HOUSE" FEATURES CLINTON AND GORE RALLY**

**Washington, D.C., July 15, 1992 -- On Friday, July 17, at 5:00 PM (ET)** C-SPAN's "Road To The White House" will wrap-up this week's Democratic National Convention with a kick-off rally for presidential candidate Gov. Bill Clinton (D-AR) and vice-presidential candidate Sen. Albert Gore (D-TN) from New York City.

The rally will begin a cross-country bus tour from New York City, through St. Louis, MO and ending in Arkansas.

**On Sunday, July 19, at 9:30 PM (ET),** "Road To The White House" will air highlights from the bus tour including campaign appearances in Burlington County, NJ, Coatsville, PA and York, PA.

*"Road To The White House," C-SPAN's weekly program focusing on the 1992 elections airs every Friday and Sunday to give viewers unique insight into the candidates and issues surrounding the race for the presidency. "Road To The White House" is part of C-SPAN's overall Election '92 programming which includes: live press conferences, debates, live Viewer Call-In Programs, local news simulcast of election results and gavel-to-gavel coverage of the political conventions.*
