It is because the cost is much lower say for a \$100,000.00 dollar policy than recent proposals for higher taxes on everything to include energy. A person is buying something that could be tax deductible and thus if Bill Clinton accepted this idea with Congress and Senate support a middle class tax cut could be realized. Remember that NDLIC is sold with the intent that Uncle Sam is the beneficiary. 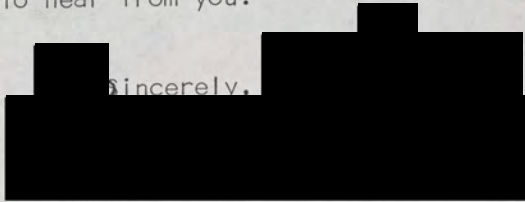

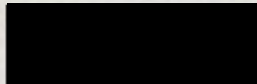
