He said they will be resolved but not during his lifetime. He is out in front on both issues.

The first cousin of Mr. Justice Scalia is a local businessman who has been at my home as a customer. He said his cousin is low key and not a person one would pick out as a member of the Supreme Court. He seems to be siding with Mr. Justice Thomas.
