Dear Mr. Lamb:

I enjoy C-Span very much, particularly your segment and the manner in which you conduct yourself. You are very fair and certainly do not reflect any favoritism when posing questions to your guests. Thank you.

Whether or not you react to a few of the statements I pose, I'm hopeful you consider their value. :: NO ONE, to my knowledge, has suggested how poorly MUNICIPAL, COUNTY and STATE governments have been operating.
