RICHARD THORNBURGH DISCUSSES S & Ls, SOUTER NOMINATION ON C-SPAN

U.S. Attorney General Featured on Live Viewer Call-in Program

Washington D.C., August 20 -- U.S. Attorney General Richard Thornburgh will discuss the Department of Justice's efforts to prosecute savings and loan crime and other white collar crimes on C-SPAN's Live Viewer Call-in program on **Wednesday, August 22, from 8:00-8:45 AM (ET)**.

The Attorney General will also comment on the recent Supreme Court nomination of Judge David Souter. Judge Souter's confirmation hearings are scheduled to begin Thursday, September 13.

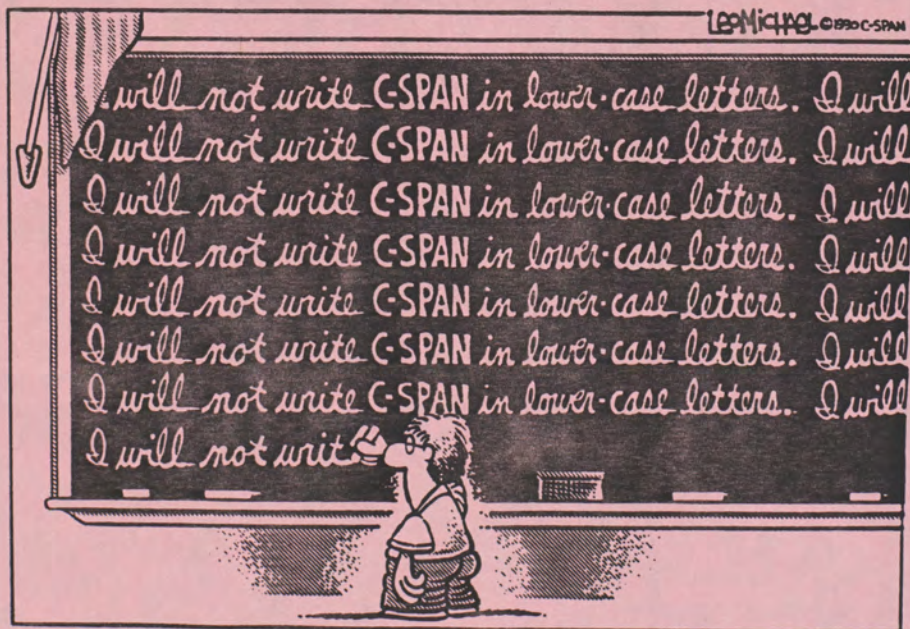
