Will we ever see the Russian news program about Bill Clinton in its entirety?

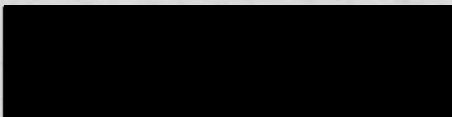
I have watched this blasted show three times in the hope that the first two times, other obligations forced you to abbreviate the program. This is apparently not the case.
