the English language and delivery.

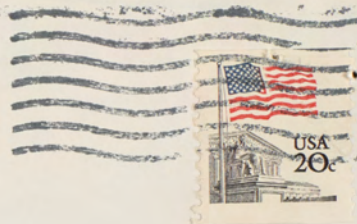
For years, I have been tantalized by little scraps of reporting from
