**C-SPAN FEATURES PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES ON
"ROAD TO THE WHITE HOUSE" THIS WEEK**

Washington, D.C., August 19, 1992 -- President George Bush and Vice President Dan Quayle will be featured on "Road To The White House" this **Friday, August 21, at 5:00 PM (ET)**. The Republican candidates spoke at a Bush/Quayle rally in Gulf Port, Mississippi.

C-SPAN will also air an address by Democratic vice presidential candidate Sen. Al Gore (D-TN) to the Illinois State Fair, in Springfield, IL.

On **Sunday, August 23, from 9:30-11:00 PM (ET)**, "Road To The White House" will focus on a bus trip through Cleveland, Erie and Buffalo with Gov. Bill Clinton (D-AR) and Sen. Al Gore.

"Road To The White House," C-SPAN's weekly program focusing on the 1992 elections airs every Friday and Sunday to give viewers unique insight into the candidates and issues surrounding the race for the presidency. "Road To The White House" is part of C-SPAN's overall Election '92 programming which includes: live press conferences, debates, live Viewer Call-In Programs, local news simulcast of election results and gavel-to-gavel coverage of the political conventions.

SENATE SELECT POW/MIA COMMITTEE HEARING LIVE ON C-SPAN

--Ross Perot is First to Testify--

Washington, D.C., August 9, 1992--At 9:30 AM (ET) tomorrow, Tuesday, August 11, C-SPAN, the Cable Satellite Public Affairs Network, will provide live coverage of a hearing before the Senate Select Committee on POW/MIA Affairs.

The first witness on the list is Ross Perot, who will be asked to discuss his trips to Southeast Asia in 1969-70 and 1987, as well as his recommendations to various Administrations.

Also testifying in tomorrow's hearing is former U.S. Ambassador to Laos McMurtrie Godley (1969-1973).




