And in addition, the host could announce the same. the idea being viewers or interested persons, could then get in touch with the caller, to get more specific information, or to make suggestions. If you did not want to put the callers name and address on screen or announce it, you might assign a caller a id. screen number, that viewers could access by touch tone phone to get that callers, name address, phone number ect... a short preamble, to remind callers to be prepared would be an idea. I believe the audience would come up with some solid ideas, and if they have a interesting or novel idea or solution, to be prepared for a lot of Mail! what do you think?
