GERALDINE FERRARO SAYS SHE'S CONSIDERING U.S. SENATE RUN IN '92

Former Congresswoman Reveals Plans In Live Interview on C-SPAN

Washington, D.C., January 25 -- Former Congresswoman Geraldine Ferraro (D-NY) said last night she is seriously considering running against Sen. Alfonse D'Amato (R-NY) in 1992.

Ms. Ferraro was interviewed on C-SPAN after the public affairs network aired the Washington Press Club Foundation's annual "Salute to Congress" dinner, this year entitled "Political Women's Power." Ms. Ferraro was asked if she was interested in running for the U.S. Senate. Ms. Ferraro replied:

"I'm looking at the race in '92 in New York. But it's a long way away and one doesn't start campaigning or moving too early.

"In January of next year, I will take a poll and if I find that it is do-able, I will do a poll against any prospective primary opponents, because there will be a primary, obviously. And I will do a poll to see how I fare against the incumbent senator. If it's do-able, I will do it.

"I feel very strongly about participating in policy-making. I want to have an impact on what's going to be done for my children and my childrens' children into the future.

"So, I will look at it in January of next year. And if it's possible, I'm going to do it. And if it's possible, I'm going to win it."

Ms. Ferraro, the Democratic vice presidential candidate in 1984, served in the U.S. House from 1979 to 1984. Her C-SPAN interview, along with the "Salute to Congress" dinner, will be re-aired in its entirety around the country on C-SPAN at 4 p.m. ET on Saturday, Jan. 27.
