AWARD-WINNING C-SPAN SCHOOL BUS JOINS WITH MARSHALL CABLE TV TO VISIT MARSHALL, MISSOURI

WASHINGTON, D.C., APRIL 28, 1997 – The award-winning *C-SPAN School Bus*, a 45-foot television production studio and demonstration center, will visit Marshall, Missouri on Tuesday, April 29 from 9 am to 1 pm CT.

The C-SPAN School Bus will visit two school on it visit: Marshall Senior High School on 805 S. Miami Street and at Marshal Middle School on 565 Odell Street.

Each bus stop is coordinated through a local cable system. This visit is sponsored by Marshall Cable TV which provides C-SPAN on Channel 16 and C-SPAN2 on Channel 15 to the Marshall area. More than 100 systems are currently scheduled to host the Bus throughout the 1996-97 school year.

Now on its fourth nationwide tour, the C-SPAN School Bus continues to visit schools and cable communities to introduce students, educators, and viewers to the political process. This year, the Bus staff will provide students with a front row seat to the 105th Congress and the workings of the legislative branch. The Bus staff will also demonstrate to teachers how to incorporate C-SPAN's programming into lesson plans for the classroom.

While traveling the country, both C-SPAN School Buses will also be used as television production facilities to gather programming along their routes. The Buses will also produce vignettes for C-SPAN's *Washington Journal*, the daily morning public affairs program which airs weekdays from 7 - 10 am ET and weekends from 8 - 10 am ET.

On the Bus, visitors will also learn about C-SPAN's online services. The C-SPAN site, located at **www.c-span.org**, provides LIVE video web coverage of the House and Senate as well as public affairs events, schedule information, the C-SPAN School Bus web page and an online congressional guide which includes bios, photos, and roll call votes.

The C-SPAN School Bus embarked on its first tour in November 1993 and was joined by a second Bus on January 1, 1996. In 1995, the C-SPAN School Bus received the Golden CableAce and Beacon awards for its unique contribution to the community and for bringing the political process to life for educators, students, and viewers.

C-SPAN, the political network of record, was created by America's cable television companies as a public service. C-SPAN is currently available in 70.2 million households. C-SPAN2 is available in 46.1 million households nationwide and worldwide via satellite.
