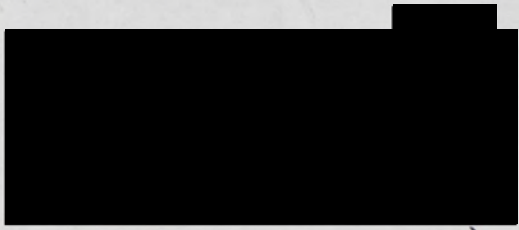
Dear Mr. Lamb,

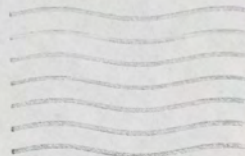
