Gentlemen:

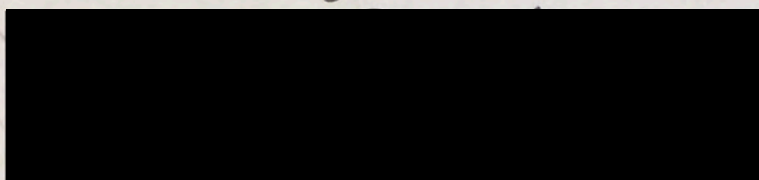
