

 state of Ohio that Laura Mays replace Dixon on the Cleveland Public Schools Board Financial Planning and Supervision Commission.  
 Morgan, who is employed with the Greater Cleveland Convention Bureau, said that she has "not enough time" to devote to thinking about the issues that she will bring to the school board meetings.

Smith, who was appointed by White to the presidency of the board of education of the Cleveland Public Schools, said that the issues that he is concerned about within the school district are financial accountability, security, improvement in proficiency test scores and maintenance of the school buildings.  
 David Carney, who is a law instructor at the George Gund College of Law at Case Western

Reserve University, said that he is concerned about the number of superintendents and school board of education members that the Cleveland Public Schools have employed.  
 Carney said that the high number of superintendents and school board of education members ensures that the school board policy will not be coherent.  
 Dixon, who is a restaurant owner and president of the board of trustees of the GCRTA, said that he has experience as a "macromanager" and is concerned about security problems and low proficiency test scores.  
 Carney also said that he did not believe that the mayoral authority for the Cleveland Public Schools will be eliminated in the year 2000.

Judge White said that the citizens who live within the cities which encompass the students who attend the Cleveland Public Schools have the opportunity to put the mayoral authority to a referendum in the year 2000.
