To the C-SPAN Network:

At the conclusion of many C-SPAN broadcasts there is a written notice stating that C-SPAN is supported (paid for) by the various cable companies as a public service to cable viewers.

If it is intended to be a public service, how come it is not part of the basic service fee, but of the premium basic? When cable companies were recently required to provide more equitable rates they complied, but also changed their definitions of what constitutes "basic service." Please see copies of the enclosed "before and after" channel listings which indicate what is basic and what is premium basic.

It occurred to me that the cable companies must be getting a tax break for supporting C-SPAN. What exactly defines a "public service" action on the part of cable companies and what public access is mandatory by law before a cable company can state that it is performing a public service?

C-SPAN is one of the two main reasons that I wanted to subscribe to cable. But I am boycotting their redefining of "basic" and as of this month will only subscribe to the basic 2-13 channels.

Please let me know if cable companies can legally relegate C-SPAN to the higher rate. And even if they legally can, something does not sound right or fair about it.
