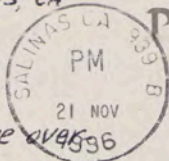
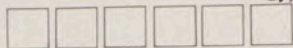

Dear Mr. Lamb,

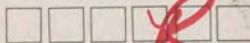
My husband and I are over
