If the Republicans have any Kinsella news briefing to m @ 2 or 3 or 4 a.m.

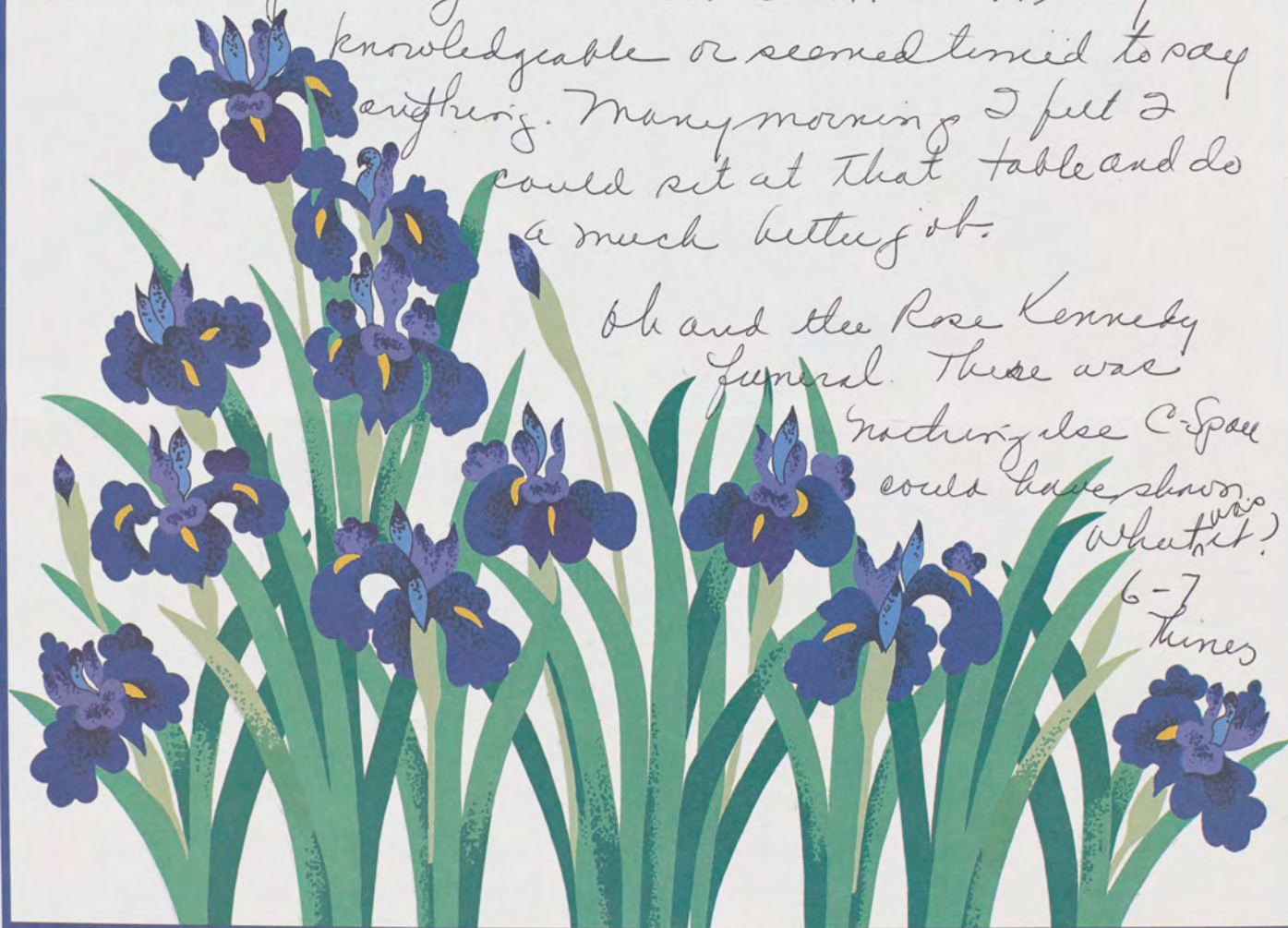
