I like where you put up that explanation of what was going to happen in the Congress March 28, 1995.

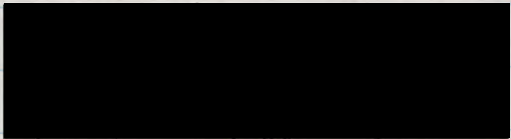
I would also like to say that the persons that set up this government did set up term limits. In those times how many of them thought they would live to be 50 or 60 years old. (Freedom new)
