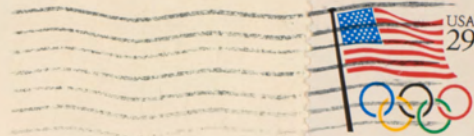
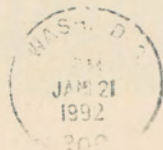
I believe too much emphasis is placed on New Hampshire. The state does not represent a fair cross section of our beloved country, among other things.
