Dear President Bill:

We have come a long way from the time you promised us "Change" at your Inaugural address in 1992. Repatriation of the Kosovars is the final stage of your legacy of foreign policy to establish the presidential international concept of American human rights - by spectacular aerial war against the brutality of President Slobodon Milosevic of yugoslavia under United Nations authority independent of the Congress but with NATO troops. I call your attention to the highlights of administering Near East Relief law which established American concept of human rights by Congressional law in response to the Armenian genocide/holocaust 1915-1923, but, in the case of the Armenians in Turkey, the reverse happened of what you have achieved in Kosovo.

The Near East Relief (NER) law provided what you achieved in Kosovo, "...to give relief, to repatriate, to habilitate and to reestablish those made destitute and dependent by the vicissitudes of war and the cruelties of men beyond their control...", was a response to what Ambassador Morgenthau and Consul Leslie A. Davis reported to the State Department, but this report did not go to President Woodrow Wilson nor to the committees on Foreign Relations of Congress but to James L. Barton that, "The Armenian extermination is fast approaching its conclusion."

In answer to this State Department report James L. Barton, International Secretary of American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions (ABCFM) and philanthropist Cleveland Dodge formed the Committee on Armenian atrocities (CAA). On September 16, 1915 the CAA made two decisions; one was to raise funds for relief; the second was for cover for the greatest violation of the human rights of all Americans including the American Armenians and all humanity since- "To exclude Armenians from CAA, to be an all-American body, to be non-political, and absolutely neutral."

This decision of September 16, 1915 was confirming the secrecy of the State Department of a century 1829-1928 administered by missionary leaders/admirals and has remained effective to this day upon the President and Congress as upon you in the instance of the Armenian genocide/holocaust. Because Wilson accepted this as a shield against involving in the war. This secret operation of the State Department had started with the Treaty of 1830 with Turkey to assure the safety of missionaries but was based on the decision of American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions (ABCFM) in 1829 as a policy for the State Department for religious war against the Armenian Apostolic Church and the rest of Christians in Western Asia accusing the Armenian Apostolic and other Churches for, "...for being corrupt..functionary..devoid of the gospel."

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"To evangelize the Armenians..to reform the Armenian Apostolic Church...to reach the Moslem populace..to improve the morals of the people in the region (Western Asia)..", this decision was made when zealous and fanatic missionary leaders found out that the religious conditions under which Armenians and other Christians were living was so strictly controlled by Turks killing other Turks for reneging their commitment to Islam.

By 1928 5,000,000 Christians had been eliminated from Western Asia and still continuing as a consequence of USA then and since being "absolutely neutral". This horrendous crime was deportation/death marches/slaughter in the hills, valleys and the deserts of Arabia ignored by missionary leaders as Turkey was in military and civilian censorship. This crime was disobeyed by faithful Muslim Turks who needed Armenians for their services, for their sexual gratification and for their personal and official concept of Human rights. By and large this was the way Armenians were being saved, during the war and genocide to 1918 and of over 2 million Armenians in Turkey in 1914, by 1918 692,200 thus being saved.

The genocide in Turkey was a horrendous crime against the Armenians as missionary leaders were accessory witnesses according to the decision of CAA on September 16, 1915 ,

"To be absolutely neutral",

but in "the land of the free and the home of the brave",

"Absolutely neutral" posture of USA was a religious/diplomatic/political/military crime against all Americans including the American Armenians fighting against Germany as a crusade for peace, democracy, establishing justice and freedom of subject races. When the CAA established "absolutely neutral" in "the extermination of Armenians" in secret on September 15, 1915-1928, Theodore Roosevelt's keen sense understood the deception by the CAA and called the CAA promoting fund raising by public protests against Turkey, "Ignoble souls and professional pacifists."

Roosevelt upbraided Wilson for not declaring war against Turkey and Bulgaria. For his criticism of Wilson and AAC, Roosevelt was threatened by Wilson a congressional "gag law". When Roosevelt threatened to take Wilson to court, Wilson backed down.

Despite such hostility of CAA and Wilson, Roosevelt offered qualified to raise a volunteer army of 200,000 to attack Turkey in the middle in the region of the former Armenian kingdom of Cilicia. At this opportunity to establish the true humanity of America, deceitfully the CAA was promoting by raising funds "for the starving Armenians and the Armenian martyr nation." Even before these funds began to be collected by a November public meeting, honest missionaries in Konya distributed relief for six weeks to 500,000 Armenians deported by rail as witnessed by this writer and family and those saved. Funds collected by CAA could not be distributed to Armenians on deportation death marches and the missionary leaders disassociated themselves from Armenians and honest missionaries not to offend Turkish official administering the genocide, otherwise safe by the mercy or avarice of Turks.

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On foreign policy Wilson and House were working like one person. House representing himself as "president's envoy of peace" to Kaiser Wilhelm of Germany and to British Foreign Secretary Sir Edward Grey as a confident friend. Both Wilson and House together agreed that, secretly House communicating with Grey, would side with the Allies. This was the beginning of secret diplomacy. In this instance House considered his discussions with Grey binding but to Sir Grey Wilson/House letter assured that USA would declare war but ignored Wilson dictating terms of peace as the Allies had the Sykes-Picot agreement to partition Turkey. This was devastating to Wilson and still Wilson thought House was the only one he could count on.

In the third year of WW I, by January, 1917 worried House suggested to Wilson that USA be prepared for war. Wilson responded,
"There Will be no war!",
by then German submarines sinking Allied and American ships reached 800,000 per month. Theodore Roosevelt had been campaigning for preparing the USA and to enter the war since October, 1914 the third month after the start of the world war. In March, 1917 desperate Roosevelt at the Union League with his shrill voice shouted,
"There is no question of going to war.
Germany is already at war with us.
The question is whether we shall fight
nobly or ignobly."

On April 2, President Wilson declared war on Germany, and in The White House personal secretary Tumulty observed Wilson crying and whimpering like a spoiled child bemoaning the fact that the Congress and the people were cheering the declaration of war. Wilson, in his physical weakness and schizophrenic dual personality of super intelligence expressed in verbiage and vindictive emotional escape from responsibility, was not acting against the genocide of Armenians nor declare war against Turkey because of CAA's decision,
"to be absolutely neutral in the extermination of Armenians", and,
General John J. Pershing, in Command wanting to build an American Army of 3,000,000 to attack Germany independent of the Allies, delayed the engagement of the American troops under command of British and French generals participation in the war till August, 1918, 17 months after declaration of war on April 2, 1917.

Upon the declaration of war, Philanthropist Cleveland Dodge suggested and Barton organized the Council on Foreign Relations to influence the Peace settlement. Cleveland Dodge financing the CAA was the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Robert College operating under American laws as all other powers operated by the Capitulatory treaties with the Sultan. But the independence of USA had permitted American evangelical missionaries to preach in Turkey without a US treaty with Turkey 1812-1829. In 1829 ABCFM decided,
"to reform the Armenian Apostolic Church",
supported by the US treaty of 1830 with Turkey. This was a international political invasion of the established relations of Armenians as subjects of Sultans of Muslim countries but without standing in the courts.

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At the same time House was organizing the House Committee for peace terms. By then all powers were exhausted and tired of the war. On the way to France in December on the WASHINGTON both of these delegations and what Secretary of State designated as his delegation were a conglomeration of the three groups. On the WASHINGTON Wilson assembled the whole captive delegation and asked them to make suggestions of issues he should fight for. The delegation and all Americans and American Armenians were prepared for the creation of an Armenian state for "the starving Armenians and the Armenian martyr nation."

A document by evangelical theologian William Hall and Harold A. Hatch was published as "Recommendations for Political Reconstruction in the Turkish Empire" surfaced on December 18, 1918 while Theodore Roosevelt was seriously ill with his chronic malarial battle. In place of Roosevelt, the Honorary President of American Defense Society, President Stewart Davison responded in a letter, "...as far as American Defense Society is concerned we care nothing at all any matter of detail; We have accepted as principle that the Armenian people should be free and independent and leave it to the Peace Conference to settle the boundaries of what shall be Armenia."

Also in November, 1918 the NER personnel started to arrive in Turkey and Armenia though NER law was not signed by President Wilson until August 6, 1919. In the interim of November, 1918 and August 6, 1919, the century of missionary leaders/admirals were administering foreign policy, under the control of the State Department till now, was transferred to the Congress by NER law legally not in effect until August 6, 1919. It is in this context that the condition of health of President Wilson was recorded by his physician, Admiral DR. Gary Grayson, "Wilson had a little stroke. Wilson was discombobulated, his leadership crumbling, crumbling and crumbling."

By December, 1918 missionary leaders had adopted the same purpose of ameliorating the conditions for the Armenians as European powers had for centuries, but the American version was for the whole Ottoman Empire as in the Hall-Hatch Reconstruction of Ottoman Empire. But by then Ottoman Empire was occupied in Arabia by the British with French forces with a division of 5,000 Armenian volunteers under British General Allenby. A last stand at the Capital Yerevan by Armenians achieved a nominal independence imposed on Armenians on a small mountainous part of Armenia insufficient to sustain the population and imposed a treaty of vassalage to Turkish wishes. That little Armenia was now governed by Russian Armenians living for a century free from Turkish persecution but in Russia with the revolutionary leaders in Georgia.

As Russian Armenian leaders came to rule Armenia, Turkish Armenian hero, Antranik Ozanian, left that Armenia with his "First Armenian Offensive Army" (FAOA) and liberated Zangezur (souther part of present day Armenia) and entered Nagorno-Karabakh to liberate the Armenians there from Muslim Azeri lords. British General deceived Antranik and obliged him to winter in Zangezur by

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assurance that the Peace Conference will settle the question of Armenia. This deception of Antranik was deadly. Had Antranik known the reality, Antranik staying and fighting on in Nagorno-Karabakh could have changed the whole world situation, but the satisfied Russian Armenians were also indifferent and unappreciative of Antranik and what the Turkish Armenians suffered.

This ironic situation was further intensified by the total failure of Wilson at the Peace Conference. As indicated in previous letters, Wilson's total failure at the Peace Conference was expressed by William C. Bullitt, Advisor-Attache to the State Department, in the letter of resignation of May 17, 1919 at the Peace Conference, "Our Government has consented now to subject the suffering people of the world to new suppressions, subjections and dismemberments - a new century of war."

This forecast of Bullitt has been fulfilled in this century and you, Dear President Bill, have rectified the errors of the State Department in your leadership in the spectacular aerial war against the brutality of President Slobodon Milosevic of Yugoslavia by day by day exposing the world by television presentation of the sequence of the war. Thus while Theodore Roosevelt established his humanity by "principles", which the then politicians resented, you by using the simple "Change" as your policy have eliminated the secret operation of the State Department, but still you are subject to the two centuries of denying the Armenian genocide by misinformation to Americans at home and in Turkey by censorship on all Americans by Admiral Bristol supported by missionary leaders.

The signing of the NER law and its contrary administration permitted the success of missionary leaders and High Commissioner to Turkey Admiral Mark L. Bristol to establish an American dictatorship of Bristol independent of Wilson and the Congress Bristol using the naval wireless to propagandize "friends" in USA to deny the resumed second phase of the Armenian genocide/holocaust. Dictator Bristol supported Kemalist revolutionary bandit army extended to 1928 by Wilson's "Armistice without victory" applied to Turkey by British Foreign Office but not applied to Germany. For this diplomacy Bristol was praised by Caleb Gates as a great diplomat and was given Command of the Pacific Fleet.

Meanwhile the Young Turk leaders loosing the war had escaped and the control of Turkey was taken by the Sultan. Sultan's Government surrendered Turkey to British control. The Sultan in august, 1918 proclaimed the return home of the deported and was attempting to rectify the harm of the deportation. The powers in control of Turkey were the Sultan and the British and Bristol censoring all Americans. Oblivious to these conditions missionary leaders as in the Hall/Hatch report were attempting to gain a mandate of the whole Ottoman Empire at the expense of the Allies and to the detriment of the Armenian republic. President Caleb Gates went to the American Delegation at the Peace Conference to promote the American mandate of the whole Ottoman Empire. Though Wilson rejected it, now Dictator Bristol supported by missionary leaders was not deterred as he applied NER funds to Turkish orphans and widows and orphans as,

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"Charity to the criminal as well as the victim."

The confession this great international crime was made in 1928 by James L. Barton - missionary/diplomat since 1886, International Secretary of ABCFM, Chairmen of the Committee on Armenian Atrocities and the Director of NER, when Barton stated,

"..had Greeks, Armenians, Syrians, Assyrians and Nestorians in Turkey and Northern Persia (Iran) denationalized themselves, given up their religion (Christianity) and become Mohammedans centuries ago, the events of 1914 and 1915 would not have happened."

This was an insult to Americans who gave their wealth and life for the, "Starving Armenians and Armenian martyr nation", and it was an insult to the Armenian martyrs, their ancestors and, in our times, an insult to the descendants of Armenian martyrs by Presidents and Congress denying the Armenian genocide to this day. Dear President Bill! Having restored the principles of human rights as Theodore Roosevelt established as commander of the VOLUNTEER ARMY up San Juan Hill and his presidency for 7 and 1/2 years 1901-1909, I ask you to reinstate the NER law as mentioned in the NEAR EAST and adjoining areas to establish stability in the region as you are doing and as Armenia and Nagorno-Karabakh have established despite genocidal crimes and blockade by Azerbaijan supported by Turkey and our State Department.
