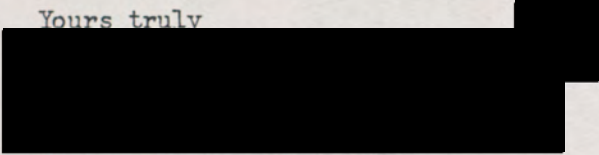
Dear Mr. Panetta:

Here is a suggestion on how the Administration and the Congress may possibly restore the taxpayers' faith in U. S. GOVERNMENT.

Give the taxpayers a box score on your statements and predictions and compare your estimates to the actual results. The Administration must be accountable for its flat out statement that the President's Budget WILL REDUCE THE DEFICIT and which was agreed to by a majority of the Congress.
