Dear CSPAN:

I have watched your morning call-in show for the past two and a half years. Today, for the first time, the content of your programming was so offensive I turned off the set.

The "info-mercial" the Clintons put on in the Rose Garden tent was as phony as anything I've ever seen the producers of Saturday morning kids' commercials perform. I am surprised, and dismayed, that CSPAN allowed themselves to be used in this manner.

It was apparent to the most naive of viewers that this program was as staged and choreographed as anything Hollywood or the networks have yet tried to force down the throat of an increasingly nauseated public.

I would have believed your producers were far too astute to let public officials get away with such play-acting. I've always found the content of your shows to be very high quality, and that you attempt honest journalism.

I cannot think that you would have run this programming unless you were paid to do so -- any more than networks have run Perot's "info-mercials" without payment. And yet, I do not want to know whether you were paid, or whether you succumbed to "shill" of your own accord.
