Why do the American people claim that Government is dishonest. When themselves conduct business the same way. Insistenting Government agree with their policy and forget about democracy.

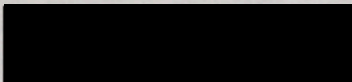
Problems that face President Clinton. He can only make a slight change.
