The lead is currently under investigation. I will notify you of its final resolution.

LEAA's efforts to advocate for the victims of crime are to be commended.

Ours is a particularly difficult case. It is only through the efforts of organizations, such as LEAA, that awareness is raised about the issue of child abduction and

lead-finding occurs to assist in the recovery of my children.

Parental abduction is not a benign crime. Often, it occurs in the setting of physical violence. Always, it is detrimental to the children and left-behind parent's welfare.

Again, I wish to give you my heartfelt gratitude for placing the faces of my children and their abductor in front of your members.

Hopefully, this publication will result in the recovery of Hans, Heather, and Laurel, and justice brought to Neil Holmgren.

### LEAA Voting Bylaw

Section 1.4 Voting. Each member in good standing shall, in accordance with these Bylaws, have one vote at any membership meeting at which he or she is present. All members in good standing shall be entitled to vote for the At Large Director position(s). Active Professional Charter members in good standing shall be eligible to vote for all positions on the Full Board of Directors.

Proxy voting will not be permitted at any membership meeting or election. Individuals who wish to vote shall be required to present credentials that are acceptable to the Executive Board or its designee, prior to voting. No person will be entitled to vote at any meeting unless all applicable dues are paid in full sixty (60) days prior to the date of the election or vote.
