We were appalled that you didn't cover the Robert Kennedy Memorial Ceremonies on C-SPAN I. Most of us aren't even offered C-SPAN II. We can't believe you failed to carry that, at least on a delayed bases. Robert Kennedy was and is more important than may Presidents and Kings, and what do we have to say about the Kennedy family. Instead, you carried things such as "Book Notes," and "The Road To The White House," which, at this time, is more irrelevant than a race for Dog Catcher. 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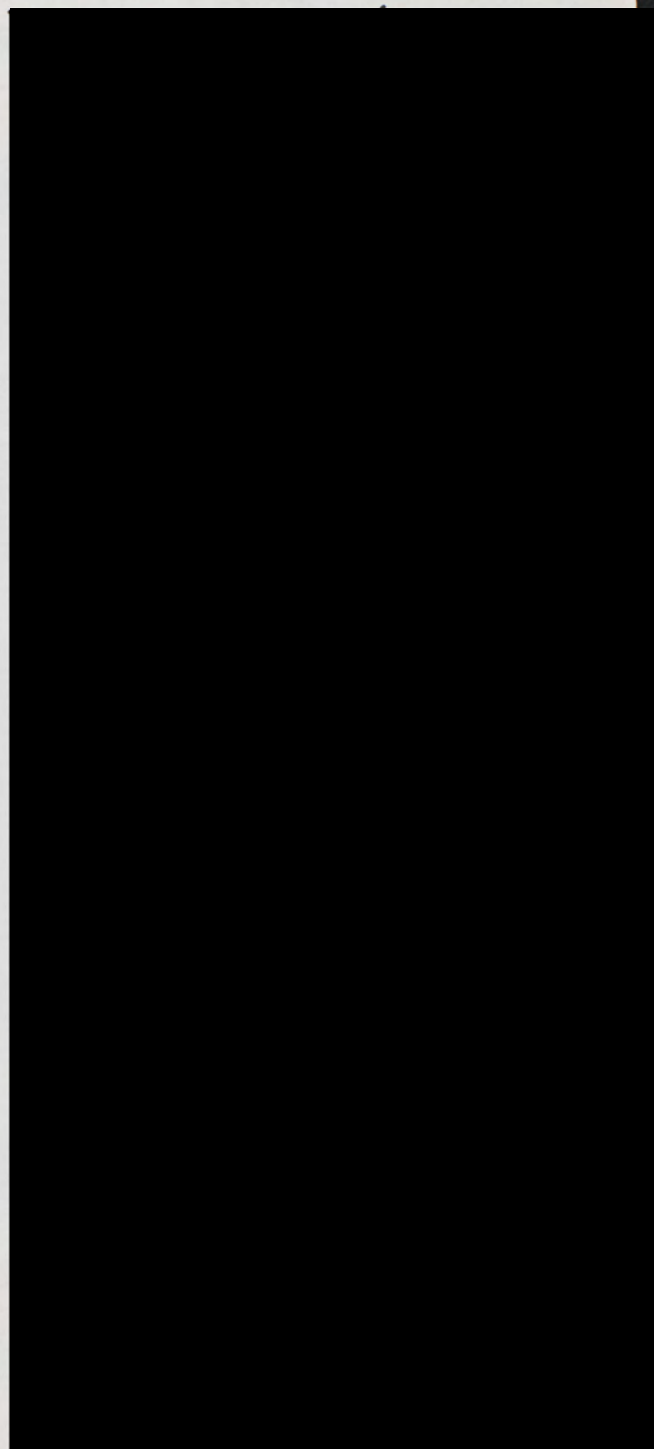
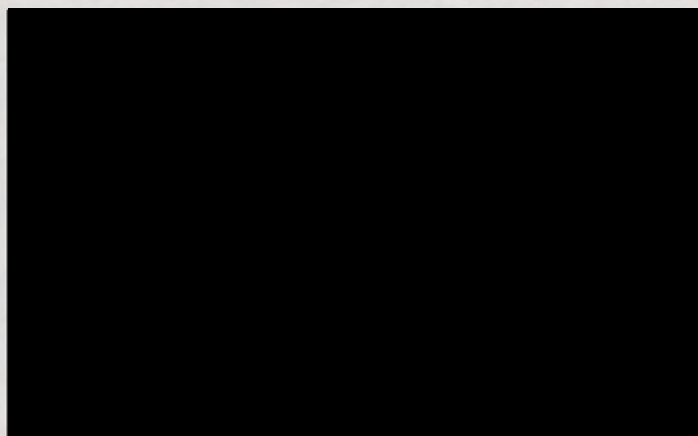
