and forth in front of the camera also.

I was watching a live debate, Thursday
nite, around 8pm, when a Senator
whose name escapes me, spoke
for over an hour, and directly
behind him, on camera, was a female,
you didn't see her face, only
her legs and they were crossed,
(at a level above the Senator) She
was there for the full hour!

I have limited my disgust of
what I have been seeing, to just these
2 incidents, and ask that you
please do something to better
control what goes on around the
camera and where it is focused.
A suggestion of mine, would be

put yourself in the place of
a viewer, and what would
you enjoy seeing?
