Japanese plants

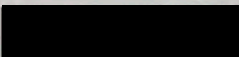

A unitary tax on foreign carmakers would balance out the fairness issue.

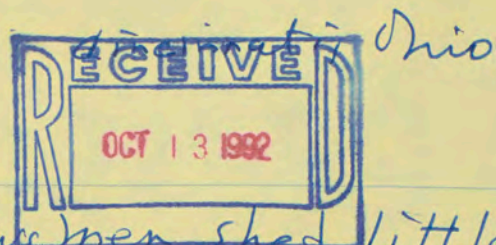
All our wars have been won with the backing and aid of U.S. machine-tool companies, yet Reagan and Bush allowed their defense departments to buy machine tools made in Japan.
