Dear President Clinton=

HAITI

There are only three realistic alternatives available to you in dealing with the horrendous situation in the above country=

(A) Continue this inhumane and idiotic embargo which is only inflicting great suffering on the Haitian people while this cold-blooded murderer, drug dealer and phony general, Raoul Cédras and his gang of cowardly thugs, steal millions of dollars black marketeering and desperate Haitians refugees try to escape to Florida while you and your advisors dream that on some beautiful day Cédras and his thugs will suddenly repent and give all this up and "step down"—which is nothing but a transparent euphemism for doing business with terrorists, which is in blatant violation of our stated national policy of not doing business with terrorists.

(B) Lift the embargo which will only strengthen and legitimize Cédras and his murdering and raping thugs while supplying them with even more to steal and sell on the black market while they continue to terrorize the Haitian people and force them to try to escape to Florida in ever-increasing numbers. And for us to try to differentiate between economic and political refugees is an exercise in futility and arbitrary discrimination, because every single one of these refugees is both an economic and a political refugee.

(C) Eliminate Cédras and his cowardly thugs once and for all. And there is only one militarily sound

way to do that and that is to hit them with a small force of our best trained killers in a surprise commando raid as soon as possible without any further warnings - the purpose of which is to kill Cédras and his top henchmen. Because as soon as their cowardly thugs hear the Americans have killed Cédras and some of his top henchmen, most if not all of them will immediately try to join us, or they will throw away their guns and run away. You can count on it. Our commandos should strike at dawn's early light by helicopters. If possible they should all be volunteers, single, mostly or a large proportion of African-Americans, with orders to take no prisoners. They must kill anybody who tries to oppose us. The Haitian people will welcome our men as liberators -

Anybody who tells you that you shouldn't do this simply does not understand the situation or is trying to sabotage you politically as Bush, Dole, Gingrich, McCain and Quayle have already done because the last thing they want is for you to succeed at this - or anything else for that matter. You can be sure if Dole was president he would have done exactly what I propose, long ago. His proposal that a committee be formed to study the situation is politically motivated claptrap and he knows it.

Those who talk about forming an international military force to invade Haiti simply don't understand how difficult this will be.

Make no mistake about it. You have only one military, political and moral option and that is (C) Eliminate Cédras and his cowardly thugs once and for all. You will have to do it sooner or later. So you had better do it now.
