She explained your company
position on this matter very well.
She was most understanding.

Still, I must express my regret,
anger, & frustration to you about
the loss of this valuable infor-
mation station.

This, along with C-SPAN are the
ONLY unfiltered news sources we
have in the United States.

We are able to see the Congress
(House & Senate) and their hear-
ings with out bias comment
from either side, for ourselves!

C-Span II also enabled me to see programs I might have missed on C-Span during the day which helped me fill in the complete picture.

We have Cable here and in Florida, but U.S.B. up North where there is no Cable. Over the air Television is 50 Biased with their arrogant anchors, and their stupid sit-coms, that we cannot be without Cable or a "disk" for some fairness and intelligence!
