Dear Mr. Murphy,

I am writing to you to express my deepest concern about the upcoming presidential debates and the present day democratic process.

The decision making process that determines who participates is not fair, and does not reflect the true meaning of political freedom. It is not possible to fairly represent the population of the United States by limiting it to a two party system. But this is exactly what has happened for many years.

The criteria established by the Commission are clearly skewed in favor of Republican and Democratic candidates. Major party candidates have a much greater access to free media exposure.

The only criterion for debate participation should be gaining ballot access to garner a sufficient number of electoral college votes to win the election.

I believe that any candidate who has accomplished ballot access has a right to be heard, and should be included in the national debates.

My desire is to urge you to guarantee that Dr. John Hagelin, who has practical, proven solutions to the nation's problems, be included in the presidential debates.

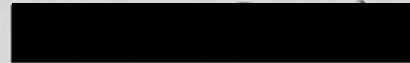

INTRODUCTION

BACKGROUND

The Natural Law Party of the United States of America was formed on April 20, 1992, in Fairfield, Iowa—the heartland of America. The Party was established to “bring the light of science into politics”—to introduce the most up-to-date and effective solutions to the nation’s problems.

CANDIDATES
