

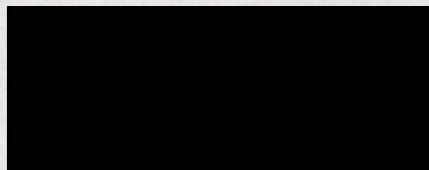

I was away on vacation during the week for Andrew Johnson and unable to call in the following question: Was Andrew Johnson the only political figure to hold every major elective office in the American political system? I would be interested in hearing the answer if you could weave it in somewhere in the remaining segments of the series. President Johnson held the following offices in his more than 40 year political career: alderman and mayor of his hometown, Greeneville, Tennessee; served in both houses of the Tennessee state legislature; civilian governor of Tennessee & military governor during the Civil War); served in both houses of Congress; vice president and president; and I believe was the only ex-president to be elected to the Senate.



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
