Boyd 1962 - Georgia Tech - wrestles with Thomas - a big  
graduated and moved to Elgin AFB. breakthroughs

after retirement calls to the Academy - Clinton was absent -  
See of Alabama - all night long read 20 minute passage  
from Hegel

Sept 3, 1976 - 11 page destruction and creation - with a few  
exception it is the only thing Boyd ever wrote  
"a new explanation on how we perceive physical reality"

Korea - March 27, 1953

Damaged only one MiG - not allowed to fly into  
Manchuria - did it anyway - He was a real talker  
some didn't want to sit with him at dinner  
He was "a great stick" single minded about aviation  
MiG kill ratio at end of war 10 to 1 792 MiG shot down  
78 F-86s

After Korea Boyd sent to Nellis AFB for 6 years.

Las Vegas - became integrated March 1960

Boyd taught - 20+ year olds -

no fighter pilot will ever be humble 1951

B. got flight training at Columbus, Miss. / proposed to Mary in Ottawa  
Married at Christmas.

1952 - arrived Williams AFB, Arizona - F86 flight training

What is it to "hose" an enemy - What's a pipper

Sept 1952 - reported to Nellis for F-86 training

Stephan Boyd from Feb 14, 1953

Aug 8, 1959 still at Nellis - 5 1/2 yrs.  
writing a manual - had to do it on his own time - he felt  
he would snap if he had to write. -

Story of Ron Cullen - First Lt. Red Corvette - drunk - pocketed  
up in Las Vegas. - Boyd tells him he needs a perfect score

Manual - 150 page "Aerial Attack Study" - everything a fighter  
needed to know was in manual - Boyd went colonials head
