
September 27, 1991--Letter to Ironwood Daily Globe Editor----

On October 12, 1992, I, for one, will recall a history lesson I had in the Seventh Grade at Washington School, Bessemer, Michigan. More, I will recall that my parents considered the United States of America as the real hope of the world, as they immigrated here to the Iron-Copper Country from Sweden, where they had never met, but did meet and marry in Houghton, Michigan.

Oh, the history lesson---Columbus Day remembers October 12, 1492, soon to be 500 years old, when three Spanish Sailing ships, The Nina, Pinta, and Santa Maria anchored at Plymouht Rock. 284 years later, in 1776, Thomas Jefferson's generation conceived the Declaration of Independence and the first "prototype" of a "most favored nation" had been born, and it was known as the "thirteen colonies", a beginning, a first "small step for mankind" in the creation of what has come to be the United States of America, as we will know it on October 12, 1991, exactly one year before October 12, 1992, when people will have the work of generations of people, 500 years old, to say that they have a right to do with earth as they wish, when they wish, how they wish, and/or for whatever purpose they wish, and I must admit that I am not any different, in wanting to do as others may wish---Except that my parents taught me that I had to work and earn my way to govern what I want to do---they taught me that Democracy was the greatest form of government in the world, and it should be obvious in that Michigan was the 26th State to ratify the original Constitution of the United States of thirteen colonies, and the United States of America is now 50 states, elects one President, 100 Senators and 435 Member to Congress, all in Washington, D.
