I have followed the recently concluded confirmation hearings of Judge Thomas and offer two observations:

First, whatever the outcome of the Thomas' confirmation he can never be a respected Justice of the United States. Nor can any of the Senate panel ever be a respected public servant. Both Hill and Thomas, regardless of their veracity, displayed more moral fiber, scruples, and a sense of fair play than any panel member with the possible exception of Braun of Colorado. Pompous asses, most if not all!

Secondly, you and your colleagues do a superb job. One can only wish that the American community of journalism would learn from the C-SPAN example. Journalistic fairness and objectivity are not perceived to be part of the regular menu of television in general and the major networks in particular.

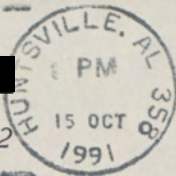
