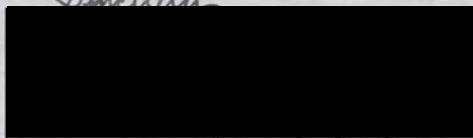
I have 2 questions regarding the above paragraphs:
