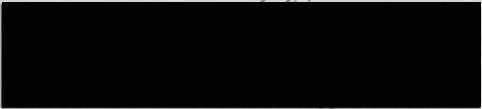
It seems our lawmakers are gun- ho to spend another trillion on the word of a handful of
